

HAVANA, January 27.

The Diario reports, on the authority of official dispatches, that Palma, Sarius, Cobre, and other towns are full of fugitive insurgents and their families, and that three thousand of them have presented themselves to the authorities and received amnesty.

At Baracoa several chiefs gave themselves up and were pardoned.

Other accounts from the interior, received through Spanish channels, represent that the insurgents are surrendering at many points to receive the benefits of General Dulce's proclamation; but in the vicinity of Santiago the rebels continue very active. They ~~are now attacking~~ attack the troops, and it is reported that they have destroyed by fire half a dozen large plantations near the town.
