

The Express says that the English Minister denies that Great Britain has had under consideration the question of the Cuban insurrection; declares it a preposterous report that it was ever designed to recognize the insurgents as belligerents, and says the Government is not even informed of the existence of a provisional government on the island. Her present relations with Spain and with the majesty of governments are highly friendly, and regard the report hereby contradicted as intended to embitter the relations between the United States and Great Britain.
