

Cuban Affairs—Ketchum to be Pardoned.

New York, July 4.

The Cubans in New York are arranging a series of concerts, beginning in the middle of July, in aid of their cause. Many friends of Cuba have sent contributions to make up for losses in the recent expedition.

The friends of Ketchum, the forger, say Gov. Hoffman has promised to pardon him within a few weeks. In case of a pardon, the District Attorney will endeavor to have him tried on a new indictment.

Officer Campbell, who shot Richard Long, during a riot, last night, has been arrested. Another disturbance was threatened to-night, and an extra police force was detailed.

The release of the Cuban prisoners on their own recognizance is understood to be a virtual discharge, as very few of them have any money. They marched to their old rendezvous in Houston street, and were then disbanded. Ryan and his men have not arrived in the city, and there will be no energetic efforts to capture them.
