

Cuba.

The Cuban Junta in this city yesterday received a mail from President Cespedes which contained news of great importance. Puerto Principe is to be attacked on the 15th inst.; the attacking force are only awaiting the arrival of artillery, which has been recently landed. The whole number of vessels so far landed in Cuba with men and supplies for the revolutionists is nine. The whole number of filibusters landed is 2,600, mostly Americans. General Quesada has in his command 7,000 men, well armed and supplied, besides 8,000 men enrolled who have no arms except the machete. The army is in good health and has a superabundance of provisions.
