

WASHINGTON, June 28.—Cubans here have further encouraging advices by mail to 18th inst. The prevalence of cholera and fever in the Spanish army is confirmed. Reinforcements sent from Camaguez to Cinco Villas, were attacked by the Cubans and defeated, losing 300 men. The Cubans lost 100. The Cubans have captured Palmiras.

The expedition which landed at Nuevas Grandes and joined the insurgents, numbered 600 men in good health and spirits. The health of the Cuban army is comparatively good, they occupying healthful positions some distance from the coast.
