Washington, June 26 - Cubaus here have the following additional particulars regarding the Puerto del Padre battle between Cubaus under Marsanal and the Spaniards under Ferra: The Cuban victory is complete, capturing a large train of provisions, arms, elothing and hespital stores, and killing over 200 Spaniards. A number of Americans participated.

The Cubaus here also have information that the troops which have been concentrating South of here, numbering 1800, have all departed, and it is believed saidy landed.

The representative of the Cubans here had several interviews, with the President and several members of the Cabinet, Senators and Representatives. The assurances given them of their carnest sympathy and desire to give practical aid to the Cubans cause, gives great setistaction. A government agent will be sent to ascertain the strength and prespects of the revolutionists, and if the report is favorable, the Cubans bare, no doubt of their iramediate recognition as belligerents.

800 Spaniards were defeated and lost a conray near Los Tunas. The Spaniards at Cinco
