

FROM HAVANA.

HAVANA, Feb. 11.—Telegraphic communication with Sagua La Grande is restored.

It is reported that the leaders in the sugar district of Cienfuegos, Villa Clara and Trinidad, are Adolfo Cavada and his brother Fredrick Cavada, Alocfo Cavado, formerly the American Vice-Consul at Cienfuegos, and removed at the request of Lersundi. He was Colonel of the Philadelphia Regiment of Zouaves during the American war. Fredrick was, until last week, American Consul at Trinidad de Cuba and has just resigned.

HAVANA, Feb. 12.—Yesterday a person painted black hid behind the outer walls of Fort Puerta, for the purpose of exploding the powder magazine. The sentinel wounded him.
