Hore Battles Fighting Accounts.

HAVANA, Nov. 20—The correspondent of the New York Times gives an account of battles at Comarca, Fray Juan, Ramon, Palo Perado and Specia, between the Cubans, under Jordan, and the Spaniards, under Valmazeda. The Spaniards claim a victory at Palo Perado and Ramon; Comarca and Pray Juan were drawn battles At Sierra the Spaniards were deteated by Jordan.
