

## More Battles Fighting Accounts.

HAVANA, Nov. 20 — The correspondent of the New York *Times* gives an account of battles at Comarca, Fray Juan, Ramon, Palo Pardo and Sierra, between the Cubans, under Jordan, and the Spaniards, under Valmaceda. The Spaniards claim a victory at Palo Pardo and Ramon; Comarca and Fray Juan were drawn battles. At Sierra the Spaniards were defeated by Jordan.

The Spanish accounts report 300 Insurgents killed in these engagements. The Cuban Generals Maso and Sumayo were captured and immediately executed. The Cubans are in force on Contramaestre river, encamped near the Canto, lines extending to Yaguas and Fillipinas, a very strong position. The Insurgents killed in the engagement in Cinco Villas in October are reported to have been 169. To accomplish this result 8000 Spaniards were needed. The District is still in possession of the Cubans. The Spanish attempt to capture the Cuban camp in the Cinago De Mayata proved a failure. The Cubans had previously left and joined the forces near Cienfuegos Gloria and Soledad. The plantations at Matagorda, near Cienfuegos, were fired by the Insurgents.
