HAVANA, March 22.—Yesterday the political prisoners embarked and sailed. The embarkation was orderly. The wharves and house tops were packed.

A thief was badly beaten and taken to the volunteer's barracks. A police commissioner a supposed friend to the thief was killed. A drum head court martial has condemned the thief to death.

The Cubans cried "death to Spain!—viva cespides." Near the Governor's palace a sentinel was killed. Frequent cries of 'viva cespides were heard to-night. A riot is apprehended.
