News has been received from Kingston, Jamaca, to the 13th inst. The captain of the Louisa Crocket, in that port, died of the vomito, and the crew were dangerously sick. The vessel was loaded and ready to sail for New York. Cubans were arriving in Jamacia in large numbers. The accommodations of the quarantine had been enlarged. The colonial government proposes to introduce coolies. The work on the old plantations was reviving.
