

FROM HAVANA.

HAVANA, April 16.

In consequence of the appearance of a document in New York, signed by Morables Lennes, imposing contributions on Cuban refugees for the support of the revolutionary cause, Dulce has issued a proclamation ordering the seizure of all property belonging to Lennes, Casonova, Bromasco, Cisnerros, Criardo, and others, unless they produce the necessary proof that they have complied with the legal requirements in the transfer of their property to other parties. The Havana journals generally praise this decree of confiscation.

The rebel leader Adulero has been captured and executed at Manzanillo.

It is reported that a schooner with a cargo of arms has been captured near the mouth of the Mantua River, at the western end of the island, while trying to run the blockade.

The hotel Inglaterra took fire last night, and was totally destroyed.
