

CUBAN MATTERS.

NEW YORK, April 24.

The TRIBUNE says this city is the headquarters of the Cuban patriots. Millions of dollars have been expended in purchasing arms, equipments and stores. Nearly twenty thousand stand of arms and equipments have already been forwarded to the Cuban coast. Councils of war are nightly held. Many prominent ex-army and naval officers of the volunteer service have linked their fortunes with the Cubans. Thursday night a company of sixty men and officers put on board a tug-boat, were carried to Sandy Hook, and there embarked on a vessel for Cuba. Two weeks ago a large steamer was dispatched from this port. She touched at Cape May and took on board arms, equipments and stores, besides men from Philadelphia. Munitions and men are also collecting at Boston and several Southern cities. Several well-known ex-army officers and Cubans left last evening for Boston, from whence the next party will sail.
