

HAVANA, July 21.

Admiral Hoff arrived at Santiago, on the 11th, with three frigates, and paid a visit to the Spanish commander of the Eastern Department.

Twenty Cubans are reported killed and twelve captured by the Spaniards near Manzanillo.

Dealers have been arrested in Manzanillo for selling goods to rebels.

The loyal Cubans of Sintu and Pictu, have issued an address to their misguided rebel brethren, urging them to return to their allegiance.

The insurgents, eight hundred strong, under General Jordan, have been defeated, with a heavy loss. General Jordan was wounded.
