

## FROM CUBA.

HAVANA, July 26.

According to official reports, the number of effective regular troops on this island is 32,000, and of volunteers 4,000. The rebels state that they have 6,000 well-armed men in the field, besides a number of guerrilla bands.

Marshal Serrano has issued an order withholding the Government stipend from the Jesuit college in Havana, owing to an indiscretion of the directors.

The volunteers from Remedios have surprised a force of rebels at La Guua, and killed eighteen of them.

A skirmish occurred between Sagua and Villa Clara, in which the rebels lost twenty men, including Major Marguise.

Advices from San Espiritu state that 200 troops had captured a rebel entrenchment, with considerable loss on both sides.

A force of 800 rebels had attacked the colored militia guarding the railroad between Nuevitas and Puerto Principe, with a loss of forty. The Spanish lost on.
