PARIS, Sept. 12.

It is reported that Gen. Sickles's late note to the Spanish Government declares that, though the United States have not yet recognized the insurgents in Cuba as belligerents, still if the situation is not modified soon, they will take steps to that end.

Spain is about to dispatch twenty-four thousand reinforcements to Cuba. The first detachment of six thousand strong will embark during the present week.

MADRID, Sept. 12.

The *IMPARCIAL* newspaper confirms the report that twenty-four thousand soldiers will be sent to Cuba, and states that the merchants of Havana have raised 9,000,000 reals for their pay.
