The Leaders of the Revolution.

HAVANA, Feb. 11.—Telegraphic communication between Hayana and Sagua la Grande and Villa Clara, which had been destroyed by the revolutionists, has been restored. It is reported that the leaders of the revolution in the sugar districts of Cienfuegos, Villa Clara, and Trinidad, are Adolfo Cavada and his brother, Frederick Cavada. The former was recently American Vice-Consul at Cienfuegos, and was removed at the request of Captain-General Lersundi. He was Colonel of a Philadelphia regiment of Zouaves during the civil war in America. The latter was, until last week, the American Consul at Trinidad de Cuba, and has just resigned.
