Illness of the Captain General—The War in the Eastern Department—Municipal Expressions of Loyalty.

HAVANA, Oct 12.—Captain General DE RODAS was taken sick yesterday, but to-day he is better.

Several skirmishes have recently taken place in the Eastern Department, during which thirty insurgents were killed. The Spanish loss is not given.

A fight occurred near Santa Espirita between the forces of Spain and Cuba. The Spanish Colonel Odaly was wounded. The Cubans lost 27 killed.

Municipal corporations in various parts of the Island are sending to Captain General DE RODAS their adhesion to the existing order of things, together with expressions of loyalty to Spain.
