CUBA.

The Havana Diaro de la Marina of yester-day publishes three intercepted dispatches which, if true, are said to show that the insurrectionary movement in Spain is the work of Cuban leaders. Additional troops have left Havana for the seat of war, and twenty robels are reported to have sued for pardon at Cienfuegos.

The Ouba, at Wilmington, N. C., was yesterday surrondered to Lieutenant-Commander Pieuson, of the Frolie, who demanded the vessel under a direct order from the President. Trouble is apprehended at Wilmington from the men, who are now in the city, unrestrained by their officers, and an extra Police force has been put on duty.
