## CUBA.

The action of the United States authorities in regard to the Cuba, at Wilmington, N. C., causes, it is easily great satisfaction at Havana. The Spanish troops recently arrived in Cuba are to leave immediately for the scat of war. Considerable stekness is reported on the custern end of the Island.

A lotter has been received at Washington from Nassau, N.P., in which the writer states that the Cuban privateer Lilian, under the changed name of the Cespedes and flying the Cuban colors, had been seized as a pirate near that port by a British ship of war. The report is not yet confirmed.
