## Commodore Biggins and the Brivateer Bornet.

Commodore Higgins, of the Cuban war steamer Hornet, who is at the Pierrepoint House. Brooklyn, indignantly denies that any ulterior motive contrary to Cuban interests dictated his entry into the port of Wilmington, and demands an investigation of the charges. It appears from the testimony of his officers that the vessel only unloaded ten tens of coals when she was towed up the Cape Fear River into the barbor of Wilmington by order of the United States authorities, and that this shortness of supply and stress of weather only, induced the course puraucd.
