Commodore W. W. QUEEN, of the United States steamer Tuscarora, under date of Key West, Nov. 3, notifies the Navy Department of the arrival at that portof an English schooner having on board 120 of the men belonging to the Lillian, seized under Cuban colors at Nassau, N. P., on the 16th ult. He also gives the particplars of the seizure of the vessel, and states that she was fired into at the time she was taken, and sinking some twelve hours after, is now a wreak. The men left Nassau Oct. 29, are mostly Cubans, and the information forwarded is given by them.
