

CUBA.--A recent despatch from Havana says that the revolutionary party held a grand congress at Sibanién on the 13th of April. Cespedes presided, and over thirty representatives were present, coming from all parts of the island. Resolutions declaring that the revolutionary party is fighting for independence from Spain and annexation to the United States, were unanimously adopted. General Quesada was again elected Generalissimo of the revolutionary armies. The delegates were enthusiastic, sanguine and determined. The Havana journals announce that the insurgents have appeared in the jurisdiction of Cinco Villas and the surrounding country. Many large plantations and estates have been seized in the country by the government under General Dulce's confiscation decree.
