Troops for Cuba—Republican Loss—Prim to the Army.

MADRID, Oct. 20, 1869.

Three thousand more troops have been ordered to Cuba to assist in quelling the insurrection.

The republican leader, Salvochea, was killed yesterday.

General Prim in a circular conveys the thanks of the Regent to the army and to the loyal volunteers for the suppression of the insurrection.

Additional troops have been sent to Bejar.
