

THE CUBAN PRIVATEER.

Trial of the Officers of the Privateer Cuba.

WILMINGTON, N. C., Oct. 22, 1862.

The trial of the officers of the steamer Cuba continued before the United States Commissioner to-day, and the court adjourned until ten o'clock to-morrow. The only witness yet examined was Gordon, who said he belonged to the United States detective force. The defence expect to be able to invalidate his testimony. The trial may consume several days.

The sailors and marines of the Cuba have been quartered at the Seaman's Home by their officers, and show no disposition to leave. They have generally conducted themselves in an orderly manner.
