The Cuban Privateer. The privateer Hornet put in at Smithville, N. C., near Wilmington, on Saturday evening to get a sup-

ply of coal. Her whereabouts were discovered by Collector Rumley, who seemed a warrant for her detention, and sent a deputy marshal with some men to enforce it. She was seized and brought up to the city. The President, on being notified of the presence of the Hornet at Wilmington, held a consultation with his Cabinet, when it was decided that she could come into our ports under stress of weather and remain twenty-four hours. Despatches were sent to know how long she had been in port. but no reply has yet been received.
