

THE CUBAN PRIVATEER.

Interview of the Cuban Envoy with Secretaries Fish and Bontwell—Speedy Release of the Hornet Anticipated.

WASHINGTON, Oct. 7, 1862.

Señor Lemus, the Cuban envoy, with Mr. Ruiz, of the Cuban Junta, arrived here this morning from New York, and returned again this evening. During the day they had informal interviews with the Secretary of State and the Secretary of the Treasury concerning the seizure of the Hornet. Mr. Lemus is very confident that the Hornet will be released, but on what grounds he does not state. He contends that when the trial comes on the officers of the Hornet will be able to show that she cleared in due form from a British port. He denies the story of her officers having run her into Wilmington for the purpose of being captured.
