### **Destruction of Sugar Plantations—Capture of Taguayabén by the Insurgents—The Captain General in Havana.**

HAVANA, NOV. 14, 1869.

On Thursday last seven cane fields in the vicinity of Las Cruces were burned. Since that time four Chinamen were discovered in the act of firing another cane field. They were seized and immediately executed.

The settlement of Taguayabén, which was defended by thirty volunteers, has been captured by the insurgents and burnt.

The insurgents were defeated while attempting to capture a railroad train.

Troops have been sent to Taguayabén from Remedios.

The cholera still prevails in the jurisdiction of Remedios.

Captain General de Rodas returned to Havana yesterday from his tour of inspection.
