The Bishop of Havana at Madrid.

MADRID, Nov. 23, 1869.

The Bishop of Havana, who was recently arrested at Cadix, was brought to this city to-day under guard. He will have an examination immediately.

Cuban Sympathizers—Government Collision with the Church—The Throne Question.

MADRID, Nov. 23, 1869.

In compliance with a resolution adopted by the Cortes calling for information, the government has been obliged to submit for examination documents which implicate Spanish republicans in a conspiracy with the insurgents of Cuba.

The government has determined to adopt rigorous measures against certain bishops who left the country for Rome without passports or permission.

The journals here contradict the report which had gained some credit outside of Spain, that in many political circles the Duke of Aosta was preferred to the Duke of Genoa for the throne.
