The Expedition of Spanish Troops and Volunteers to Cienaga de Zapata—Captain General de Rodas at Cienfuegos.

HAVANA, Nov. 5, 1862.

An expedition, composed of troops and volunteers, recently left this city by sea and land to surprise a strong body of rebels at Cienaga de Zapata. No news has yet been received of the result.

The *Diario* doubts the success of the movement, believing that the rebels were apprised of it for several days in advance, and that they have by this time withdrawn into the interior.

Captain General de Rodas has arrived at Cienfuegos.
