Heary Vasquez, the Cuban who murdered his mistress, Josephine/Weiss, at No. 20 Crosby street, on the night of the 22a ultimo, by stabbling her serval times with a dazger, was yesteday brought from the Hospital on Bisckwell's Island, where he has been under treatment for self-inducted

wounds, before Coroner Keenan at the City Hatt. Having nearly recovered it was thought beat by the Coroner to have him in more secure quarters than the Hospital afforded. Consequently Vasquez was formally examined according to law. He is twentysix years of age, a native of Cubs and by occupation a machinist. In relation to the crime of murder, with which he stands charged, Vasquez had nothing to say. Coroner Keenan then committed him to the Tombs to await his tricl.
