

THE CROSBY STREET TRAGEDY.

Vasquez, the Murderer, Sent to the Tomb.

Henry Vasquez, the Cuban who murdered his mistress, Josephine Weiss, at No. 69 Crosby street, on the night of the 22d ultimo, by stabbing her several times with a dagger, was yesterday brought from the Hospital on Blackwell's Island, where he has been under treatment for self-inflicted wounds, before Coroner Keenan at the City Hall. Having nearly recovered it was thought best by the Coroner to have him in more secure quarters than the Hospital afforded. Consequently Vasquez was formally examined according to law. He is twenty-six years of age, a native of Cuba and by occupation a machinist. In relation to the crime of murder, with which he stands charged, Vasquez had nothing to say. Coroner Keenan then committed him to the Tomb to await his trial.
