The Campaign in the Central Department Commenced—Advance of General Puello.

HAVANA, Dec. 28, 1869.

Advices received here under date of the 25th inst. from Nuevitas, states that the campaign in Camaguey opened on Christmas Day. General Puello, with 3,000 men under his command, all thoroughly armed, has moved on San Miguel, from whence he will proceed to Sebanica and Guarmaro. He promises to end the revolution in the Central Department.
