La liave, vs. The Governor and Others was tried on the 18th of November in the Control Vice Admirally, before the Chief Julge, who gave judgment pronouncing the senzine of the La liave an linegal act, as the vessel was brought by force mio British waters. The amount of damages is laid at £25,000. An application was must be the Julge of the Court of Vice Admirally to grant a certificate of probable cause to the officers who sexued the cargo of the La liave. After a long address by the Attorney General the Judge refused to grant the certificate, stabut that he had not the power, nor would se if he had.

The town of Port Maria was thrown into a state of excitement on the 13th of November. Information having reached the inspector of that town that a party of Spaniards had landed at the Cove, a small fishing hamlet about three miles distant from Port. Maria, with arms and other munitions of war, the inspector despatched a party of men to the spot, where they arrested an Irishman and seized sixtynine packages of clothing, arms and ammonition. The Irishman stated that himself and nine others (including five Cubans) shipped in Kingston on board the brig Florence, bound for Cuba, but being out nine days they launched the longboat and got into it when about forty miles from Cubi. They pulled unter within ten miles, when they spied a Spanish vessel-of-war, which gave them chase. They then put about and made sail for Jamaica, and prought up in the creek where they were discovered. The Cubans held a meeting at their club in King-

The Cubans held a meeting at the Cuban hingston, for the purpose of petitioning the Governor to annul the seizure, but the result has not jet transpared.

The fourth session of the Legislature, under the
