Citizens of Matanzas to Surrender Their Arms—A Slur Upon United States Senators.

HAVANA, Dec. 30, 1899.

The Governor of Matanzas has issued an order directing all citizens having arms in their possession to deliver the same to the Spanish authorities within two days. Those neglecting to comply with this order will be court martialed.
