HAVANA, Dec. 8, 1869.

An attempt was lately made to burn the town of Jula, but it was frustrated. Many persons suspected of complicity in the plot have been arrested.

The troops from Santi Espiritu are marching towards Puerto Principe. It is supposed the intention of the troops is to destroy a rebel encampment planted on that road.
