Great excitement exists, however, on account of the Peruvian iron-clads at Key West. The insurgents have captured the town of, Mayajigua, near Remedios. Skirmishes are continually taking place in the neighborhood of Trinidad, Cienfuegos and Villa Clara. The insurgents about Cienfuegos are well mounted and supplied with artillery. The people in the Central Department have all abandoned their estates and moved into the cities. A vigorous campaign against the revolutionists is to be immediately inaugurated.
