

## THE CUBAN ASSOCIATION CONCERT.

A concert under the auspices of the Cuban Ladies' Relief Association, for the purpose of procuring funds to aid the sick and wounded of the patriot army of Cuba, took place last evening at Steinway Hall, which was filled with a fashionable assemblage.
