

Affair at Macaca—Spanish Troops En Route for Mayari.

On the 7th inst. the troops attacked the insurgents entrenched at Macaca, a small town in the Eastern Department, deriving its name from the Macaca river, and succeeded in dislodging and routing them with a loss of nine killed.

Intelligence from Santiago de Cuba to the 6th has been received here. General Velosca's column, recently stationed at Bayamo, has gone to Mayari, for the purpose of driving the insurgents under General Cepeda from that town.
