

Political Excitement—Fears of Insurrection— The Captain Generalship of Cuba.

MADRID, April 9—Evening.

Much political excitement exists in the city and apprehensions are entertained that the exasperation of party feeling will result in an outbreak of violence. The police and military authorities are taking every precaution to prevent disorder.

The appointment of General Caballero de Roda to the Captain Generalship of Cuba has not been finally determined upon by the provisional government, but should General de Roda be retained in his command in this country Don Isquierdo will probably succeed Captain General Dulce.

Additional supplies of artillery and cavalry are demanded for the suppression of the rebellion in Cuba.
