

PRESIDENT GRANT AND THE CUBANS.—The Spaniards in Cuba are, it appears, stepping rapidly beyond the recognized bounds of healthy executive action. They have laid hands on an American citizen and placed his life in jeopardy. M. Casenovia, a citizen of the United States, visiting Cuba lately, was seized and placed in prison. His daughter, a lady residing in New York, has had the case submitted to President Grant through a friend, and the President, with his usual promptness, telegraphed orders to Admiral Hoff, in command of our naval forces at Havana, to "protect all American citizens." The Spaniards will know what this means, particularly when coming from President Grant.
