Butchery of a Cuban Family by the Volunteers—Spanish Emissaries Endeavoring to Enlist Men—Prospects of the Insurgents.

WASHINGTON, April 4, 1862.

Recent letters from San Juan de los Remedios, Cuba, give particulars of the massacre of Señora Arrelondo and several of her children. Her husband had joined the insurgents, and she was enticed within the Spanish lines with her family under the pretence of meeting her husband, when the whole party were butchered by the infuriate volunteers.

Several pretended agents of the Cubans, supposed to be Spanish emissaries, have been endeavoring to enlist various individuals without authority or sanction either from the provisional government in Cuba or its representatives here.

It appears from authentic information from the vicinity of Santiago de Cuba that the insurrection is steadily progressing. Well informed Cubans in Washington believe the insurgents have by this time, or will in a few days, have secured a seaport.
