

The Case of Mr. Casanova Being Watched— Nothing Said About His Release as Yet.

WASHINGTON, April 7, 1869.

The Secretary of State to-day received a despatch in regard to the case of Casanova, an American citizen taken into custody by the Spanish Cuban authorities. Mr. Casanova was arrested for being implicated in some alleged violation of the maritime laws of the island. The gentleman is still in prison, but safe. The case is receiving the attention of the American Vice Consul, and is also being watched by the American residents of Havana. No action in relation to the release of the prisoner has as yet been taken.
