CUBA.

Gunboats to be Constructed in the United States—Arrival of Prisoners—Volunteer Demonstration Expected—Proposed Retrenchments—Confiscation Urged.

HAVANA, April 7, 1862.

Ten gunboats are expected here from Spain and thirty have been ordered to be constructed in the United States.

The artillerists that recently arrived here are likely to go to the Vuelto Abajo district.

Teodora Nunez and Francisco Gonzales, who were on the steamer Comanditario when she was captured, have been held on a vessel in the vicinity of Nassau for the purpose of recognizing others concerned in the capture.

Twenty prisoners from Esperita Sancto have arrived here.

The Governor of Guanabacoa is banishing suspected youths.

A demonstration on the part of the volunteers is expected on the arrival of the Catalan volunteers from Spain.

The *Foxe de Cuba* announces that great retrenchments have been proposed to the government. The same paper is pressing the confiscation of property because the absentees are selling.

A project has been started for the merchants to give their country debtors three months' extension of time in which to pay their debts.
