The Triennial Directory Scheme Thrown Overboard—Arrests of Members of the Civil Guard—Trouble Among the Cuban Volunteers.

MADRID, May 16, 1862.

The Cortes yesterday, after a long debate, rejected the proposition for the establishment of a Triennial Directory. It is now confidently believed that a regency will be created, with Marshal Serrano at its head.

Several members of the Civil Guard in this city have been arrested on charges at present unknown.

Trouble has arisen with the volunteers for Cuba in consequence of the non-payment of their bounties.
