

## Cuba.

The Revolutionary Junta in this city publish in full the proclamation of Cespedes, extracts from which were recently given by the Spanish authorities to show that Valmaseda's late infamous order was a consequence of it. The proclamation in full, however, shows that the Spaniards had been carrying on a war of extermination, killing prisoners, mutilating the dead and laying waste all Cuban property within their reach, and Cespedes' order was called forth by the necessity for reprisals.

The English steamer Salvador returned to Nassau on the 8th inst. from the north coast of Cuba, where she succeeded in landing all her men, arms, ammunition and provisions. Soon after her return she was seized by the Receiver General for violating the Foreign Enlistment act. The captain and several of the crew have arrived in Key West.
