The Revolutionary Junta in this city publish in full the proclamation of Caspedes, extracts from which were recenity given by the Spanish authorities to show that Valmasseds's late infamous order was a consequence of it. The proclamation in full, however, shows that the Spaniards had been carrying on a war of extermination, killing prisoners, multial-

ing the dead and laying waste all Cuban property wi him their reach, and Cespedes' order was called forth by the necessity for reprisals.
