

More Volunteers Expected from Spain—The Peruvian Monitors Gone to Martinique—Movements of War Vessels.

HAVANA, May 27, 1869.

The Spanish iron-clad Victoria arrived here to-day.

A detachment of volunteers for service in the island of Cuba is expected here by the 4th of June.

Intelligence has been received here from St. Thomas to the effect that both of the Peruvian monitors had left that port for Martinique.

The United States gunboat Narragansett has returned to this port from Nuevitas.
