• Sugar—Stock in warehouses in Havana and Matanzas, 375,000 boxes and 18,000 hhds; exports during the week from Havana and Matanzas, 48,000 boxes and 5,500 hhds, to foreign countries, and 8,000 boxes and 3,200 hhds. to the United States. Flour ~~at~~ \$9 87 a \$10 87 per bbl. Butter flat. Bacon steady at 18c. a 19c. per lb. Petroleum declining. Other articles unchanged. Freights buoyant, with an advancing tendency. Exchange without decided change.
