The Spaniards Pursuing the Filibusters—Three of Their Cannon Reported Captured—The Battle at Puerto Padre Confirmed—Insurgents Massing Near Las Tunas.

HAVANA, May 31, 1869.

The troops are in active pursuit of the filibusters who landed in the Bay of Nipe, and have captured three of their cannon and killed Manuel Quarrez, the commander of the riflemen.

A heavy engagement has taken place at Puerto Padre.

The insurgents are massing their forces in the vicinity of Las Tunas.

A skirmish is reported near Cienfuegos between the regulars and insurgents.

Captain General Dulce's order sending a number of political prisoners to Spain has been revoked.

The British brig James Crow, with a cargo of molasses from Cienfuegos for New York, was lost on the 23d inst., and her crew have arrived at Batá-dano.
